From oil field engineer to the assembly line to journeyman electrician

When Mohand and his family moved to Columbus from Algeria in 2019, he was grateful to secure a job with Stanley Electric making \$15/hour. But with degrees in biology and engineering, and experience working as a manager at an oil refinery, Mohand sought a new career path. He faithfully learned English, was promoted at Stanley Electric and enrolled in an electrician apprenticeship program. Within nine months, he had passed his journeyman electrician's test with a perfect score! Now, Mohand makes \$59/hour plus overtime—and is on his way to securing a better future for his family. Says Mohand, "The people at the RIC encouraged me to be patient, earn recognized certificates in the U.S. and try to look for new career paths to reach my goals. Now I'm able to open doors for better opportunities for my young children."

# Thank you CAS and Heart to Heart Food Pantry!






Heart to Heart comes to the RIC once a month to bring much needed food and produce to ease the financial burden of increasing food prices.
