Top 4 Immediate Needs

- **Driver:** Drive our neighbors to appointments or pick up supplies like baby items, OR help our neighbors learn to drive by helping them practice driving
- Homework Helper: Assist our neighborhood kids with their school work Monday Wednesday, 5:30-7:30pm.
- Language Assistance: Help a neighbor learn English by teaching (or assisting) a small class, or pairing up with a neighbor as a conversation partner.
- Office assistant: 1-2 hours/week in the office: Assisting staff as needed including entering service data greeting visitors/neighbors, answering questions, and scheduling appointments
